In this way people can more easily donate towards named projects the Trust can reclaim tax on the donation. This can represent for the Trust as much as 28P in every pound of tax paid by the donor. The main projects I am currently responsible for are the following:

- a) Completing the construction of, equipping and inaugurating five nurseries.
- b) Establishing medical attention in each one and building a central clinic to service them and for the general use of the community).
- c) Building a centre in each sector to provide organization, skills formation courses etc in each community.
- d) A community Micro-finance scheme
- e) A feasibility project for potable water (Water has to be bought from tankers and stored in barrels for use).
